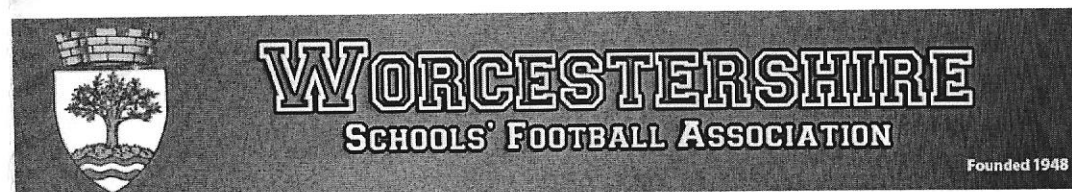

Lewis Drew (Capt) – Def – The Ron Vlaar of the side, natural born leader, Rock at centre half, Threat going forward from set-pieces. Youngest and the best of three brothers who have all been through school football.

Freddie Downes – GK – Enigmatic goal keeper and character who has made the number 1 shirt his own. Good shot stopper one of a number of Villa fans in the squad.

Joe Sandham – Def – Mr reliable, solid. Strong attacking full-back famous for his mazy runs forward. Has played occasionally in the age group above at school and never lets anybody down.

Max Lowe – Def – Most improved footballer in the squad in the last 12 months, versatile, tough tackling, defender who can play anywhere across the back four. Can also be an effective defensive midfielder when required. One of the quietest members of the squad but lets his football do the talking.
