



## PROCESS FOR SEPTEMBER 2019 ADMISSION

---

Prince Henry's High School is a 13-18 co-educational Comprehensive School with approximately 1,300 pupils, including a strong traditional Sixth Form of approximately 340. Prince Henry's was designated as a Specialist Language College in 2002 and took on a second specialism in Mathematics and Computing in 2007. In March 2011, Prince Henry's became an Academy, received an "outstanding" general inspection in 2013 and following this, the school was awarded Teaching School Status in May 2014. We were successful in our School-Centred Initial Teacher Training (SCITT) application and welcomed our first cohort of trainee teachers in September 2017. In 2016 Prince Henry's was recognised by the Department for Education as one of England's top 100 non-selective state schools in terms of student progress from KS2 to KS4.

### YEAR 9 ADMISSION

Prince Henry's welcomes applications from both within and outside the catchment area. Places are allocated in accordance with our admissions criteria (which can be found on the school website or by contacting the school). Traditionally a number of places are allocated to students who live outside our catchment area.

- Please include as much information on the form as you can; the Worcestershire form does not allow space to record **siblings who, at the time of application, attend Prince Henry's**. This information should be entered in the additional details column.
- If you are about to move house, please attach the proposed timings and the new address.
- If you wish to make a case for special consideration (eg for medical reasons), please include the relevant documentation from the professional dealing with your child **at the time of application**.
- When entering your preferred school please check the drop-down menu carefully to ensure your selection is correct.
- When you have submitted your application it is advisable to **print out the confirmation e-mail and check that the information is correct**. Keep this in a safe place!

- Remember you can change your application at any time up to the deadline of 31st October 2018.

## **YEAR 12 ADMISSION**

Parents are warmly invited to attend our **Entry to Sixth Form talk to parents on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019** in the **Arts Centre Evesham at 7.00pm** when there will be a presentation about the courses and opportunities in Prince Henry's Sixth Form. On **Friday 7<sup>th</sup> December 2018** prospective applicants are also invited to attend our '**Experience Sixth Form Day**' when they can participate in Sixth Form lessons and spend the day shadowing some of our Sixth Form students. This day is particularly useful for students who currently attend schools which do not have a Sixth Form. Students hoping to join PHHS from another school can receive an application form by contacting the Sixth Form Office or by downloading the online form, and this must be submitted by **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2019**. Late applications may be considered but your option choices and/or offer of a place will not be guaranteed. New students may be interviewed, but the interview does not form the basis of an offer and is intended to provide an opportunity for students to discuss their options. All applications will be acknowledged by the end of March.

Any offer of a place will be subject to the student obtaining the results required for entry and chosen subjects. After results day, students from outside Prince Henry's will need to attend a Consultation Session with proof of results. They will meet with a senior member of staff who will check that their chosen subjects are suitably matched to their results.
