## **A-Level & GCSE Exam Results Arrangements**

I would like to confirm our anticipated arrangements for collection of the A-Level and GCSE examination results. The A-Level results will be available on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August and the GCSE results will be available on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August.

This year the students will receive examination results, which will look no different from any other year. As I have highlighted in my previous letters, as in previous years, the grades for 2020 are being awarded by the examination boards and not the school. The only difference is that the school submitted Centre-Assessed Grades as the students did not sit examinations. The grades awarded by the examination boards, could be different from those submitted by the school, but the only grade that matters is the one awarded by the examination board. Staff will not be able to discuss individual Centre-Assessed Grades on the Results Days.

I am sure you will not be surprised that we have had to make some significant changes to the way in which our students can collect their examination results this year. Normally, as I am sure you will have seen from previous photographs and video footage, these are very-well-attended occasions, and over the last few years, our usual venue has been in the Arts Centre Foyer. Whilst we want to celebrate with our students and advise them accordingly, we have planned to use a larger venue, which will be set up in a way that the students can receive their results with enough space to remain socially distanced. Understandably, sometimes students can get emotional when they receive their results, so we would ask you to support us in maintaining a safe environment for all.

### **Year 13:- A-Level, Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

Students in Year 13 will be able to collect the results from the Sports Hall between 8am and 11am. Please use the main entrance to the Sports Hall. To manage the volume of students and maintain social distancing, there will be a one-way system in place and once students have collected their results, they will be asked to leave the Sports Hall via a rear exit.

If students require any consultation or support, our usual Sixth Form team will be available in school and we will advise accordingly.

### **Year 12:- Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

We anticipate a small number of students in Year 12 will come into school for their results. They will be able to collect the results from the Sports Hall between 11am-12pm. Please use the main entrance to the Sports Hall. A one-way system will be in place and once students have collected their results, they will be asked to leave the Sports Hall via a rear exit.

### **Year 11:- GCSE, Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> August 2020**

Students in Year 11 will be able to collect their results from the Sports Hall between 9am and 11.00 am. Please use the main entrance to the Sports Hall. To manage the volume of students and maintain social distancing, there will be a one-way system in place and once students have collected their results, they will be asked to leave the Sports Hall via a rear exit.

Should a future local or national lockdown be imposed, then we plan to deliver the results to the students electronically. We will provide information in the next few days about the protocol on the website. We will be carrying out a trial of this system in the next few days with Year 13 students only, and we ask that you encourage your child to follow the instructions on the website to access their school email, which we will use to send their results only in the event of a local or national lockdown.
