All lessons are delivered by staff in a positive and encouraging learning environment, enabling students to explore the issues and ask further questions. Staff teaching Year 9 will have also received training from a Health professional working within Worcestershire Health and Care Primary Trust. Relationships Health and Sex Education in Year 9 focuses very much on Healthy Relationships, Grooming, the impact of Pornography Contraception and Sexually Transmitted Infections. Any questions and issues that students themselves raise are dealt with in a professional and sensitive manner. This unit gives a good foundation on which to build in Years 10 and 11 to include more challenging issues such as abusive relationships and the significance and recognition of Consent.

We do wish to reassure you that all lessons will be taught, and issues dealt with and discussed, in the most sensitive and suitable manner, that is in keeping with the values of the school.
