Covid Second Vaccination for 12 to 15 year olds Tuesday 25th January 2022

The school has been contacted by the Vale of Evesham Primary Care Network (Vale PCN), who have informed the school that students who have not yet received their second Covid Vaccination will be offered this in school on **Tuesday 25th January 2022**. Many students will have already received their second vaccination from their own surgeries.

The Vale PCN have requested that the school distributes consent forms to all students between the ages of 12 to 15 years of age. ***These consent forms should be completed and returned to your child's form tutor by Friday 21st January.*** Please note that vaccinations cannot take place without a consent form completed by the parent.

There are Parents' and Children and Young Persons Guides from NHS England on the school's website alongside an online copy of the consent form. A paper copy is also available from the form tutor if necessary.

Please note that the school is only acting as venue for these vaccinations. Any student who has contracted Covid 28 days prior to the 25th January will not be eligible for the vaccination at this session. Any queries about these vaccinations should be directed to the NHS helpline on 111. Any students who will not be able to have the vaccination on 25th January will need to contact their own Doctor's practice.
