Dear Parents/Carers

We are pleased to be able to offer students an exciting opportunity to visit France during the summer term. We will be spending 5 days in and around Criel-sur-Mer in upper Normandy. The visit will take place from Monday 5th to Friday 9th June. Students will enjoy a 4-night stay in an historic 17th century mansion, set in 4 acres with a multipurpose sports complex and plenty of rooms for evening activities. Pupils will stay in rooms of 2-6 on a full-board basis. The trip includes visits to local areas of interest, accompanied by a native French speaker, where pupils will be able to experience French culture and practise their language skills in authentic settings. There will also be a programme of on-site activities, all involving spoken French, in order to get the maximum cultural and linguistic value from this fun-packed experience. The cost of the trip is **£495**.

Spaces are limited so in the first instance, we are asking students who would like to attend the trip to return the form below to Student Reception by **Monday 12th December**. After this date, if the trip is oversubscribed, the names of all students who have expressed an interest will be entered into a ballot and names selected at random. Once the names of students have been confirmed we will require a **£100** deposit via Parentpay by **Tuesday 3rd January 2023** with a second payment of **£175** by **Friday 17th February** and the remaining balance of **£220** due by **Friday 24th March 2023**. The travel company have set a minimum number required for this trip to be viable, in the event of this number not being met; the trip will not be able to go ahead.

Your child will need to have a valid passport with at least 6 months left on it and European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) or the new UK Global Health Insurance Card (GHIC). Therefore, if they wish to travel, please apply for these as soon as possible. Before committing to this trip parents/carers should check the COVID regulations for the countries of travel. If a place is confirmed for your child following the ballot, please apply for the relevant travel documents as a matter of urgency. If there is any other information that you feel should be passed on at this point e.g. serious health issues which we would need to notify the Insurance Company of please let us know on the reply slip.
