As part of the assistance given to our Sixth Formers choosing their career paths we will provide a range of opportunities in the months ahead to provide information and guidance in preparation for life after sixth form.

HIGHER EDUCATION FAIR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WORCESTER THURSDAY 23rd MARCH 2023 – 12.30pm – 2.00pm

The event is organised by UCAS. It will be held at the University of Worcester and is an ideal opportunity for students to speak to representatives from virtually every university in the country, all under one roof. It also gives students the chance to collect large numbers of prospectuses. (Spaces limited to 120 students* - £7 charge for transport). **Places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis with payment being received via parentpay and the student handing in a completed consent form to Mrs Tranter in the Sixth Form Office. Due to safety concerns, the university will not allow us to exceed our allocation of 120 students, so we will not be able to permit students to travel independently to the University once the trip is full.* A copy of the consent form is attached to this letter. Because each student needs to be booked individually by school, students need to pay and return their consent form by Tuesday 14th March.

THE 'NEXT STEP' CONFERENCE Wednesday 7th June 2022 (9.00 – 1.00pm)

Each year we offer a very successful 'Next Step' conference to our Year 12 students with guest speakers from the world of work, apprenticeships and universities. Admission tutors from a variety of universities hold sessions on topics such as writing the Personal Statement, choosing a university, subject choices, finance and student life. We have had representatives from the Universities of Birmingham, Aberystwyth, Worcester, Loughborough and Swansea in the past. We will also host speakers who run sessions focused on employment, apprenticeships, other alternatives to University and GAP Year options. We will be running a similar conference this year and students will be asked to choose which seminars they will attend nearer the time.
