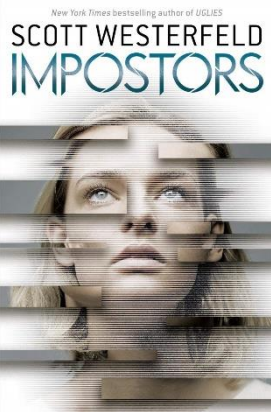

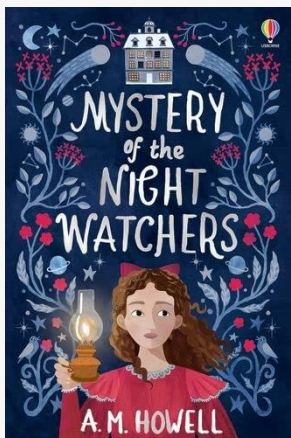

Behind the Lens

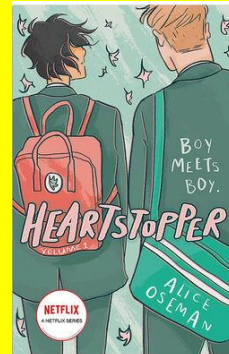
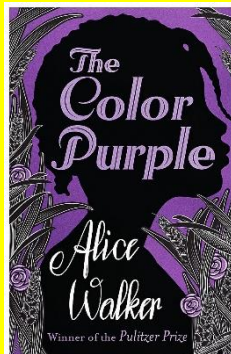
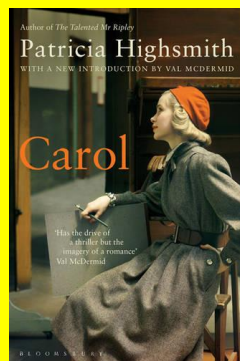

World Book Day changes

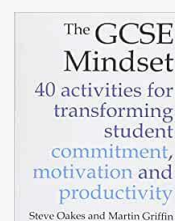
