Berlin Trip March 2023

Dear Parent(s)/Carer(s)

I am writing to you with some final updates for the upcoming Berlin trip, 29 March - 4 April 2023.

We have recently been made aware of an update to legislation in Berlin. This change allows all adult swimmers to swim topless in public swimming pools should they wish to do so. This change is in addition to long-standing legislation in Germany that has legalised this on beaches. The itinerary for our upcoming visit to Berlin, which includes a visit to Tropical Islands, remains unchanged. This is following consultation with Senior Leadership at Prince Henry's, trip staff and our tour provider Connect Studies. This change only relates to adults, therefore does not affect the expectations for students.

I have finalised arrangements regarding the storage room for students to leave their suitcases. On the day of departure (Wednesday, 29 March), please could students drop their cases into the DofE/ Head of House office at the back of the PRH from 8.30 am. A member of the trip staff will be there to meet students and supervise this. Suitcases will be stored here securely throughout the school day. Students are expected to attend school in full uniform on Wednesday, 29 March and attend their lessons as timetabled. Year 10 have a Rewards Assembly that morning so please leave ample time to drop off cases beforehand.

In a slight change to our departure time, we will now be leaving Prince Henry's at **4.30 pm sharp** on Wednesday, 29 March. Students will still have the option to return home briefly after school to change and collect suitcases should this be feasible with timings. We respectfully ask parents and carers to drop these students back **no earlier than 4.00 pm** so as not to increase congestion generated by our existing school bus departures. For students who are remaining in school, we will ask them to change into their own clothes in the PE changing rooms following afternoon registration and then wait in Henry's before we depart.
