Birmingham – Year 13 Geography Field Trip – 28 September 2023

As part of the A-level course, students are required to undertake out-of-classroom field work. To fulfil this course requirement we intend to take the Year 13 Geography students to Birmingham City Centre to carry out some urban Geography investigations. The date of the visit is **Thursday 28th September 2023**.

The trip will consist of an itinerary of activities provided by the Geographical Association and will include a teacher-led walking tour starting in the Jewellery Quarter and ending near to New Street Station. The location offers our students the opportunity to study the issues of gentrification and urban change in Birmingham. Students will have the opportunity to practise a variety of skills which support the Non-Examined Assessment (NEA) component of their A-level. This element is worth 20% of their final grade.

At the end of the tour, students will be given some unsupervised free time to eat their lunch in the area around New Street station. Staff will brief students about the meeting place, provide a school mobile number and students will stay in groups of no less than three.

Students should meet in Henry's at 9.00 am, ready to depart by coach. School uniform should be worn and students should bring a coat in case of wet weather. We will arrive back at school at 3.15 pm, in time for the buses. The cost of the trip is £12 per student. Please complete and return the consent form to their Geography teacher and make payment via ParentPay by **22nd September 2023**.
