Shakespeare Lecture, Malvern Theatre

We have managed to secure tickets to a lecture on Shakespeare at the Malvern Theatre on Wednesday, 8 November 2023. This is an opportunity for A Level English Literature students to broaden their knowledge and understanding of Shakespeare's plays. The lecture is part of Malvern Theatres' 'Shakespeare Folio 400 Festival' season and will be delivered by a leading Shakespeare scholar.

The theatre's introduction of the event reads: 'Professor Buchanan is not only the Master of St Peter's College Oxford and the Pro-Vice-Chancellor of the University of Oxford, but she is a leading authority on the 1623 First Folio of Shakespeare's plays, a work which is still one of the most important secular works ever to be published. In this well-illustrated talk, Professor Buchanan will discuss what this hugely influential volume has offered to the world.'

We will be travelling by minibus leaving Prince Henry's at 1.40 pm and we will aim to return at approximately 5.30 pm (exact time to be confirmed). Students will be reminded they should wear a seatbelt whilst travelling on the minibus. Students will be in school for the morning and we would request that they remain in uniform for the trip.
