Students will be travelling to their allocated activity by coach or minibus and will be reminded they should wear a seat belt whilst travelling. During their unsupervised time students must stay in small groups of no less than 3. **School buses will be running as normal at 3.35 pm, on Wednesday, 10 July**, however, Drayton Manor finishes after 3.35 pm and, therefore, parents/carers will need to arrange transport home for their child. Please can we ask that students are **NOT** collected by car from the car park or the vicinity of the school as this causes significant congestion with cars trying to leave as coaches arrive and vice versa.

Please make payment, **for your first choice only**, by ParentPay. If you have not activated your ParentPay account or if you need any assistance then please contact the school finance team by email to parentpay@princehenrys.worcs.sch.uk. If your child's form is not handed in within the specified week then their first choice may not be guaranteed. If a trip is oversubscribed on the deadline date then names will be drawn at random. A collection point for students to submit forms will be available in the **Concourse between 8.40 am and 9.00 am**. This payment is voluntary but where the full costs of the trip are not able to be met it may result in the visit being cancelled.
