Geography Fieldtrip - Evesham

As part of the A Level Geography course, your child should have the opportunity to complete fieldwork outside of the school grounds. To fulfil this requirement, we are taking Year 13 Geography students to Evesham town centre to conduct fieldwork on the impact of migration upon the town. The date of this visit is **Monday, 23 September 2024**.

The students will analyse the impacts of the migration upon Evesham, including the diversity of shop. The students will also have the opportunity to visit Evesham Volunteer Centre for a speech regarding refugees within the local area, the students will also have the opportunity to speak with staff and service users. This fieldwork will give students the opportunity to practise primary and secondary data collection skills, which will support the non-examined assessment (NEA) component of their A-level. This element is 20% of their final grade.

The students should meet in **H4 at 9.30 am** to undertake secondary research and should be ready to depart at **11.30 am**. Students are required to wear their school uniform, but may wear comfortable shoes and suitable clothing in case of poor weather, when we venture into the town centre. Students will have unsupervised time and should remain in groups of 3. Students must also bring a packed lunch, as there is nowhere to purchase lunch. We will return back at school no later than **3.00 pm**, in time for the buses.

There is no cost associated with this trip.
