HIGHER EDUCATION FAIR AT THE UNIVERSITY OF WORCESTER

THURSDAY 27th MARCH 2025 – 10.30pm – 12.00pm

This event is organised by UCAS and will be held at the University of Worcester. It is an ideal opportunity for students to speak to representatives from virtually every university in the country as well as some apprenticeship providers, representatives from the Armed Services and Gap Year providers, all under one roof. There is a charge of £6.50 for transport and spaces are limited to 100 students. *Places will be allocated on a first-come-first-served basis with payment being received via parentpay and the student handing in a completed consent form to Mrs Tranter in the Sixth Form Office.* A copy of the consent form is attached to this letter. Because each student needs to be booked individually by school, students need to pay, and return their consent form by Wednesday 19th March.
