Geography Fieldtrip to Slapton Ley

As part of our A-Level Geography course, your child should have the opportunity to complete fieldwork outside of the school grounds. After 2 days of successful fieldwork in the urban settings of Birmingham and Stratford in May, we are delighted to offer our Year 12 Geographers the opportunity to attend a residential trip to Slapton Ley, South Devon. The dates of this visit are from **Monday 13th October to Thursday 16th October 2025**. Please note, this trip is not compulsory.

This fieldwork will give pupils the chance to use primary and secondary data collection techniques, which will support their understanding of the enquiry process that underpins the Non-Examined Assessment (NEA), worth 20% of their final grade.

Pupils will travel to Slapton Ley Field Studies Centre by school minibus, where the specialist tutors of the South Hams area will conduct investigation days around the Physical topics of Coastal Environments, Ecosystems and Water & Carbon; not only will this consolidate understanding of the enquiry process, it will act as an impactful way in which to revise their Year 12 Physical Geography studies in a real world context.

There will be further communication in early September concerning the precise logistics and equipment required, at this stage however, pupils will be departing from school on Monday 16th at 9.30 am and may wear their own clothing. Pupils will require waterproof clothing in case of rain, comfortable footwear and clothing appropriate for Geography fieldwork.

Pupils will remain on the Field Study Centre Site in the evenings. Appropriate behaviour will be expected at all times, especially when in their dormitory rooms where they are unsupervised. It's not planned that there will be any unsupervised time but at lunch times and free times pupils should remain in groups of no less than 3.

The cost of the trip is **£360**, this price includes food, specialist field study tutors, use of external fieldwork equipment, transport and accommodation. If you would like your child to attend, please make payment of the **non-refundable deposit of £125.00** via Parentpay and return the attached consent form to **Student Reception by Monday 16th June 2025**. The remaining balance is to be paid in two further instalments of **£135 by July 14th** and the final balance of **£100 by September 5th**.
