As part of their A Level studies, students in History must complete an independent essay project. To support their progress with this, we will be giving students the opportunity to visit the Hive in Worcester. The Hive is a library with a range of resources, many of which will help students with their research. Staff at the Hive have organised a study skills workshop which will introduce students to the basics of library research. The trip will run on **Friday 27th June 2025**.

We will be travelling to the Hive by train catching the **9:36am** train from Evesham to Worcester Foregate Street, and return on the **2:09pm** train back to Evesham. Students will need to purchase their own tickets and it is suggested that this is done in advance of the day of travel.

Students will need to meet at 9am in the 6th form common room so that they can be registered before we walk to the train station as a group. On our return to school students can go straight home, there is no expectation for them to attend period 5 lessons that day.

It is compulsory for students to stay with the group and travel as per these arrangements. Students should bring a packed lunch with them. Students are not required to wear school uniform, the dress code is smart casual.
