Biology A level Live

We are planning on taking a group of A-Level Biology students to Biology A-Level Live at Birmingham University on **Tuesday 18th November 2025**.

The trip is an exciting day and the students will have the chance to hear from some of the best Biologists via a series of lectures, and attend two exam technique revision sessions from a specialist Biology examiner. The day (as well as the literature provided) will be a look forward for pupils thinking about choosing these subjects at university and show students how A Level Biology can lead to an interesting career. There will also be opportunity for the students to raise issues with the scientists.

We will be travelling by coach leaving school 9.15am. We aim to be back at Prince Henry's by 4.45pm so you will need to arrange for your child to be collected. Students will be reminded they should wear a seatbelt whilst travelling on the coach

Students will not be required to wear school uniform for the trip but should dress appropriately for attending a study day. There will be no opportunity to purchase food so students will need to bring a packed lunch with them.

The cost of the trip is **£36.50**. If your child would like to attend please make payment via Parentpay and return the attached consent form to Student Reception by **Monday 6th October 2025**. Places are limited for this trip and if it is over-subscribed students will be selected at random after this date.
