Girls in STEM trip to University of Birmingham

We are offering the opportunity for Year 9 students to attend the University of Birmingham 'Girls in STEM' event on **Wednesday 26th November**.

This event is for year 9 girls to inspire them to aim for high GCSE grades and to make appropriate choices for sixth form to allow the study of Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths (STEM) subjects at university.

The day will consist of workshops at the different STEM departments to give students a greater understanding of the opportunities for STEM at University.

Students will need to meet in **Henry's at 8am** to allow us to leave promptly. We will be travelling by minibus and we anticipate **returning to school at 4pm** so alternative arrangements will need to be made where students usually catch a school bus.

Students will need a packed lunch and a water bottle, and should wear school uniform.

The cost of the trip is being covered from the STEM budget as we feel the value of this trip could be instrumental in helping our pupils make decisions for their future careers.
