Morgan Motor Factory Visit – Friday 14th November 2025

We are delighted to announce an exciting educational visit for our Year 10 Design and Technology Students to the Morgan Motor Company Factory in Malvern, Worcestershire.

This trip is designed to provide a crucial real-world link to the manufacturing and design principles we will be focusing on in lessons. The tour will last approximately two hours and will expect to see the whole production process of the car from start to finish, exploring the wide range of materials used to build a Morgan including wood, metal and leather and the vast range of paint colours and finishes available. We believe this experience will enhance your child's understanding of industrial processes and real-world scenarios within the industry.

Students should meet in Henry's at 9am to allow us to leave promptly at 9.15am, we will be travelling by coach. We will return to Prince Henry's at approximately 1.30pm and students will be expected to be in their afternoon lessons that day.

Students will be expected to wear school uniform and should bring a packed lunch with them as there will be no opportunities to purchase food.

The cost of the trip is **£26.50**. Places on the trip are limited and if the trip is oversubscribed students will be selected by ballot.
