Dear Mr Robinson,

I am writing to seek your support in addressing an important issue affecting both Prince Henry's High School and our neighbouring community.

Prince Henry's is a school built on the principles of inclusivity, aspiration and kindness, and we take great pride in the values our students demonstrate every day. Our recent Ofsted inspection in March 2024, in which we were graded Outstanding in all areas, highlighted that our students "flourish academically," "live out the school values daily," and "benefit from a comprehensive personal development offer." This strong reputation, together with our community sports facilities and the Henrician Theatre, means the school attracts high numbers of visitors in the evenings.

While this is a positive sign of community engagement, it also creates significant traffic congestion on Victoria Avenue during events such as Parents' Evenings and our Open Evenings. This congestion impacts local residents and delays those attending school fixtures or theatre performances - an issue we are eager to resolve responsibly.

To reduce disruption and enhance safety, we would like to discuss two practical and cost-effective options:

- A temporary one-way system, directing vehicles up Victoria Avenue and down Cambria Road during large school events.
- An expansion of on-site car parking and access points to the existing tennis courts would allow for approximately 70 additional vehicles. This would be achieved by widening the lower drive, strengthening the base for the existing tennis courts and adding two access points, creating a one-way flow around the site.

Either solution would provide immediate benefits to residents, improve event access, and support the wider community who rely on our facilities. With a modest council investment, we could create a long-term improvement that enhances safety, reduces congestion, and strengthens the positive relationship between the school and its neighbours.
