On the evening, please arrive via the school's **Main Reception from 4.15pm**, where our Student Ambassadors will welcome you, ask you to sign in and provide you with a seating plan to help you locate the teachers you are meeting. Parking will be available on the school site.

As this is an in-person event, we are unable to offer virtual appointments.

The appointment booking system will open at **6pm on Tuesday 6th January 2026**. If you are unable to attend there is an option within the appointments system for you to let us know, which we would appreciate you using if this applies. Instructions on how to access the booking system can be found on the reverse of this letter. Please note that, due to the number of appointments teachers conduct during the evening, we are unable to offer separate parental appointments for individual students.
