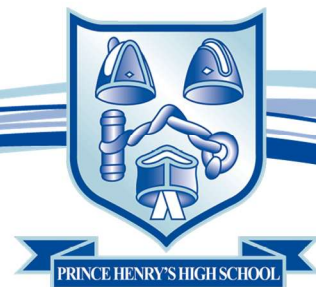

Year 10 Art & Textiles trip – Gloucester Cathedral

The Art and Textiles Department are organising a trip for Year 10 Art and Textiles students to visit Gloucester Cathedral on **Monday 11th May 2026**. As part of the GCSE Art and Textiles course students are required to explore the work of artists and designers. This trip will give students a valuable opportunity to see art and design work first hand, and build a body of recording research to extend their coursework submission.

We will be travelling by coach from Prince Henry's at **9.15 am** and will return for the end of the school day. Students do not need to wear school uniform but they should dress appropriately for the weather and wear sensible footwear. Students will need to provide their own lunch, which we will eat outside, there will be no opportunities to purchase food at the cathedral. Students will be given unsupervised time to explore the cathedral both internally and externally, and must remain in groups of no less than 3.

The cost of the trip is **£12.75**. If your child would like to attend, please make payment via Parentpay and return the attached consent form to student reception by **Monday 27th April**.
