Dear Parents and Carers,

As we approach the end of the school year, I wanted to let you know about some exciting developments taking place at Prince Henry's over the summer holidays.

This summer, the school is benefiting from well over £1 million of capital investment, reflecting a significant commitment to maintaining and improving our facilities for both current and future students.

The first project is the start of a two-year refurbishment programme for Abbey Block. This substantial investment will modernise the building and ensure it continues to provide an excellent learning environment for many years to come.

The second project is the replacement of our ageing heating system. Our existing two-boiler system will be replaced with nine smaller, modern, high-efficiency boilers. This will improve the reliability of our heating, increase energy efficiency and, we hope, ensure the school remains warm and comfortable throughout the winter months.

As part of this project, specialist contractors, will be safely removing a small amount of asbestos contained within the existing boiler room during the summer holiday when students are not on site. In the interests of keeping our school community fully informed, I wanted to let you know about this element of the project, as you may notice specialist contractor vehicles on site displaying asbestos removal signage.

I would like to reassure you that this work is taking place in a highly controlled environment by fully licensed specialist contractors and in full accordance with all relevant health and safety legislation. The boiler room is a secure plant area that is not accessible to students or members of the public, and the work has been meticulously planned, risk assessed and will be carried out to the very highest safety standards. There is no risk to students, staff or visitors. Once this work is complete, the site will return to normal operation with a modern, more efficient and more reliable heating system serving the school.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support. I hope you and your family have a restful and enjoyable summer break, and I look forward to welcoming our students back in September.
